- **Due diligence**: We will take appropriate measures to assess and mitigate risks in our supply chain. This includes regularly reviewing our suppliers and working with them to achieve common standards.
- Cooperation and commitment: We will work with government authorities, business partners and other stakeholders to support the implementation of the German Supply Chain Act and promote best practices.
- **Continuous improvement**: We will continuously monitor and improve our efforts to comply with the German Supply Chain Act. This includes reviewing our policies, processes and performance.
