Packaging type	Description	
BK01	<p>Seaworthy case packaging</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Film inside and / or outside optional ● Pipe caps optional ● Barrier layer and drying agents optional 	
BK02	<p>Non-seaworthy case packaging</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Film inside and / or outside optional ● Pipe caps optional ● Barrier layer and drying agents optional 	
BK03	<p>Non-seaworthy crate packaging</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Standard crate with 50 % covering ● Film inside and / or outside optional ● Pipe caps optional 	
BK04	<p>Square timber frame</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Open at front walls ● Without lid ● Film optional ● Field of use: mainly for components 	
BK06	<p>Pipe bundle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wooden frames ● Film optional (e.g. at the pipe-ends) ● Pipe caps optional 	
BK07	<p>Pipe bundle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wooden frames ● Ends protected by wooden caps ● Film optional (e.g. over the entire length) ● Pipe caps optional 	
BK08	<p>Heavy seaworthy pipe bundle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Packaged in film as standard ● Stronger wooden frames ● Ends protected by wooden caps ● Pipe caps optional
